Integrity, competence, impartial conduct and protection of the public are fundamental to the BSS NDT Personnel Certification Scheme. By signing this form, the candidate/certified person agrees to comply with the following Code of Ethics throughout the application, examination and certification period.

1. Comply with this Code of Ethics and all applicable requirements of the BSS NDT Personnel Certification Scheme.
2. Undertake only NDT activities for which I am competent by virtue of appropriate training, qualification, certification and experience.
3. Perform NDT work in accordance with applicable codes, standards, specifications, procedures and legal or regulatory requirements.
4. Sign, approve or endorse only records and documents relating to work for which I have personal professional knowledge or appropriate direct supervisory responsibility.
5. Seek or recommend competent specialist assistance whenever an assignment requires knowledge or capability beyond my own competence.
6. Act responsibly, professionally, fairly and without misleading clients, employers, colleagues, candidates or other interested parties.
7. Give proper regard to safety, health, the environment and the well-being of the public while performing professional duties.
8. Protect confidential and proprietary information obtained through employment, examination or certification activities, except where disclosure is legally required or necessary to protect public safety.
9. Avoid actual or perceived conflicts of interest. Where a conflict cannot be avoided, disclose it promptly to the relevant employer/client and, where it may affect certification, to BSS NDT.
10. Immediately inform BSS NDT of any matter that may affect my ability to continue fulfilling certification requirements, including changes in competence, physical capability/vision requirements, or other relevant circumstances.
11. Maintain professional proficiency through appropriate practice, experience, training and continuing technical development in the certified NDT method(s) and level(s).
12. Inform the employer or client of any significant adverse consequence that may result when my professional or technical judgement is overruled by a non-technical authority.
13. Not falsify, alter, conceal or permit misrepresentation of qualifications, training, experience, examination results, certification status, work responsibilities or NDT records.
14. Not cheat, assist cheating, obtain or disclose confidential examination material, reproduce examination questions, or otherwise compromise the security, validity or integrity of a BSS NDT examination.
15. Not make false, misleading or unauthorized claims concerning BSS NDT certification, its scope, validity or status, and not use the certificate or certification mark in a misleading manner.
16. Immediately report to BSS NDT any known or suspected serious violation of this Code of Ethics, certification requirements, or examination security.
17. Immediately report to BSS NDT any attempt to pressure, induce or force me or another person to violate this Code of Ethics or certification requirements.
18. Promptly notify my employer/client, as applicable, if my certification is suspended, withdrawn, cancelled or otherwise becomes invalid, and immediately cease any claim to valid certification for the affected scope.
19. Return, discontinue use of, or permit BSS NDT to invalidate certification documents/marks when required following suspension, withdrawal, cancellation or expiry.
20. Cooperate with BSS NDT in the investigation of complaints, appeals, alleged misconduct, misuse of certification, or other matters affecting the integrity of the certification scheme.

Acknowledgement and consequence of non-compliance: I understand that failure to comply with this Code of Ethics may result in investigation and action under the applicable BSS NDT procedures, which may include rejection of an application/examination result, suspension, withdrawal or cancellation of certification, as appropriate. Complaints and appeals shall be handled in accordance with QP-14.
